To the Members of the Douglas Planning Board:


American Pro Wind, LLC hereby requests a continuation of the public hearing for the Site Plan Review of the Douglas Woods Wind Farm from November 9, 2010 to the next regularly scheduled Planning Board meeting on December 14, 2010. The reason for the request is twofold:

1. The issue of the setbacks and how they are measured needs to be resolved before any additional review of the site plan can be done. As you know, virtually every part of the plan is dependent upon the setbacks. Per the recommendation of the Town Engineer and the Building Inspector, a written request is being submitted today by APW's attorney asking that the Building Inspector provide APW with her current interpretation of the setback measurements.
2. APW is awaiting a final written peer review report from CDM (the town's consultant) on the Shadow Flicker Study, Acoustic Study, and Flicker Mitigation Plan. Before APW can present the final Shadow Flicker Mitigation Plan to the Planning Board, it needs to see the written report from CDM.

Since no substantive additional site plan review can be done without resolution of these two issues, APW is requesting this continuation. APW is sending a certified letter to the 17 affected neighbors (shadow flicker mitigation plan) informing them of this change in meeting dates. We look forward to meeting with the Planning Board to continue the Site Plan Review on December 14th.
