REGULATION NO. 009

TRANSFER STATION

The Douglas Board of Health accepts and will comply with the provisions of 310 CMR 19.000 and has adopted the following additional regulation for the operation of the Douglas Transfer Station:

1. The hours of operation will be TUESDAY, THURSDAY and SATURDAY from 7:30 AM to 4:00 PM. The Transfer Station will be closed on legal holidays and if a legal holiday falls on the normal operating day, the Transfer Station will be open the following day.
2. No commercial packer type trucks and no summer campgrounds will be allowed use of the Transfer Station.
3. Transfer Station permits will be issued to Town of Douglas residents only. Permits will be issued on a semi-annual basis and a fee will be charged. Citizens who are 65 years of age or older will be charged half price for their permit.
4. Household items such as washing machines, stove, dryers, couches, etc. will be accepted in the bulky waste container for a fee. Refrigerators will be accepted for a fee and only with certification that the Freon has been removed.
5. Transfer Station personnel may reject any person who is not a resident of Douglas and/or may bar from disposing unacceptable waste.
6. There will be no "picking" from the compactors/bulky waste box or removal of any material from the Transfer Station site.
7. All household waste will be bagged or boxed in containers small enough to fit into the compactors.
8. Traffic flow will be on-way as indicated by paving markings and signs within the Transfer Station.
9. The Transfer Station personnel are responsible for the complete operation of the facility.

10. There will be no personal use of the Transfer Station premises which would interrupt the flow of traffic in or out of the facility.
