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## **ATTACHMENT A: WRITTEN PURCHASE DESCRIPTION** **June 20, 2018**

### **TYPE 1 AMBULANCE AND ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT**

Pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 30B, the Town of Douglas is providing this written purchase description as a guide for vendors wishing to respond to a Request for Proposals (RFP) for one new Type 1 ambulance and associated equipment, as specified herein.

Decision rule: The contract for the desired item(s) will be awarded to the responsive and responsible vendor who submits the proposal most advantageous to the Town, based upon price and comparative criteria defined in the RFP. Proposals will first be scored according to the comparative criteria. Proposals will be price evaluated in order of their ranked scores.

Minimum requirements: All proposals must meet the criteria below to be considered responsive to the RFP. The vehicle will be the front line emergency medical first response vehicle for the Town. The Town will purchase the ambulance, specified associated equipment and warranty options as a complete package. Minimum requirements as follows:

- must meet KKK-1822 F Standard, including Change 8 and Change 9 notices;
- heavy duty suspension;
- vehicle must be equipped with a power assisted loading system;
- power stretcher compatible with loading system or adapted using MCI kit;
- traffic pre-emption device;
- back up camera system;
- inverter with 1200 watt minimum capacity;
- IV fluids warmer;
- radio usable on UHF and VHF bands;
- vehicle must be painted RED;
- cabinet for two self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) setups with brackets;
- all emergency and scene lighting must be LED technology;
- patient compartment must have cardiac monitor tower on curb side;
- must include rear chevrons for highway safety and visibility;
- vehicle will be covered by a competitive or better warranty, or make such options available at a price affordable to the Town.
